


Dear Ms. Dortch:

New Jersey Public Broadcasting Authority ("NJPBA"), the licensee of WNJN, Channel 51, Montclair, NJ, has entered into a Concurrent Operations and Interference Avoidance Agreement (the "Agreement") with T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile"). Pursuant to the Agreement, as well as section 27.60 (b) (1) (iv) of the Commission's Rules, NJPBA hereby gives it concurrence for the operation of T-Mobile's 700 MHz A block license within that portion of the WNJN service contour within T-Mobile's New York/New Jersey proposed operational area. Thus, the Agreement allows T-Mobile unlimited operation within the (BEA-010) New York-North New Jersey-Long Island, NY-NJ-CT-PA-MA-VT market including said area that is within the sixty (60) mile radius from the WNJN transmitter.
